

Letter sent to Principals of Colleges

Subject: Antardhvani 2014: Guidelines for the Awards of Good Practice

Sir/Madam,

This is to gently remind you that the Annual Cultural Festival of the University of Delhi will be held from 14th -16th February 2014 along with the Annual Flower Show. You are requested not to schedule any cultural activity or college festival on those days. As last year, active participation will be expected from all the colleges on all three days. Programme details will be sent to you periodically.

Here are Guidelines for the Awards of Good Practice. This was an immensely popular and competitive item last year, and in Antardhvani 2014 the procedures have been streamlined and plenty of time given to colleges to present their best work. Kindly note :

**THEME FOR THE AWARDS OF GOOD PRACTICE:
FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME**

1. Participation from every college is mandatory.
2. The assessment of a college will begin one month prior to Antardhvani during which designated teams will visit the colleges.
3. The final judging will be conducted on site at Antardhvani by a panel of eminent persons.
4. Self-Assessment proformas regarding teaching, new pedagogy, projects and presentations, evaluation, specially relating to the Foundation Courses will be submitted by the college.
5. Video recordings of 20 minutes for Lectures, Panel discussion, Interaction with students, Inter-disciplinary activities will constitute a major part of the assessment of a college.
6. Every college will create 6- 8 page brochure on Foundation Courses with the focus on the special learnings acquired through these courses.
7. Every college will have its Information Booklet including its history, faculty profile, student activity, academic, sports, cultural and other achievements. Other publications such as college magazines and newsletters are encouraged.
8. Innovation Plaza will demonstrate the achievements of the college projects 2012-2013 and the progress of new projects 2013-14.
9. Stalls for showing Good Practices will be available to every college. The dimensions and structure of the stall, facilities, security arrangements etc, will be communicated a month ahead of Antardhvani.
10. Every college stall will have one teacher and two students at any given time in the duration of Antardhvani 2014.
11. The college is requested to send names of 2 teachers and 10 students by 15 Nov 2013 who will participate in the central team of Volunteers for Antardhvani 2014.

The above Guidelines are sent to enable the colleges to prepare adequately for the Antardhvani festival and the Awards of Good Practice. Periodically the Antardhvani Secretariat will be sending further communication. Colleges are encouraged to contact the Antardhvani Secretariat for any clarification or information.

Looking forward to your participation in a joyous and productive festival.
